Kennedy Elementary School

Areas of focus will be Keizer/McNary and West Salem schools, most notably: Claggett Creek and Whiteaker middle schools; Clear Lake, Cummings, Forest Ridge, Gubser, Keizer, Kennedy, and Weddle elementary schools.

Waldo Middle School
2805 Lansing Ave. NE, Salem

Areas of focus will be McKay/North Salem area schools, most notably: North Salem High School; Parrish Middle School; Hallman, Hoover and Washington elementary schools.

Four Corners Elementary School
500 Alma Ave. SE, Salem

Areas of focus will be North Salem/McKay area schools, most notably: Houck Middle School; Auburn, Chávez, Eyre, Four Corners, Hammond, Hayesville, Lamb, Miller, Swegle and Yoshikai elementary schools.

Judson Middle School
4512 Jones Road SE, Salem

Areas of focus will be South/Sprague area schools, most notably: South Salem and Sprague high schools; Bush, Candalaria, Lee, Liberty, McKinley, Morningside, Salem Heights and Schirle elementary schools.
